Aadhaar not linked to EPF account? Your provident fund deposits will not get credited

- Starting this 1 June 2021, your employer will be able to make provident fund remittances only if your PF UAN (universal account number) is linked to your Aadhaar
- The employer will not be able to upload electronic challan-cum-return (ECR), which contains employee's PF details, for such employees if their UANs are not linked to Aadhaar
- Employees will not be able to make withdrawals, take loans or avail any other benefits under the EPF Act until their Aadhaar is seeded into their UAN.
- Ensure that there is no mismatch between the name, date of birth and parents' names being shared with employers and the information in Aadhaar.
