NPS partial withdrawal rules explained in 5 points

Mint

- The NPS subscribers can make partial withdrawal after three years from the date of joining under specific circumstances.
- Partial withdrawal is allowed for expenses towards higher education/marriage of children, purchase/construction of residential house (in specified conditions) and treatment of critical illnesses.
- The subscriber can make a partial withdrawal a maximum of three times during the entire tenure of subscription under NPS.
- The maximum allowed limit for partial withdrawal is 25% of the contributions made by the subscriber as on the date of application for withdrawal.
- Partial withdrawal request can be made online by the NPS subscriber or he can submit physical partial withdrawal form along with documents to Point of Presence service providers.
